## **FY 2016 County Matching Grant Program**

## **County Project Detail**

<u>Beaverhead County-</u> Crisis Intervention Team training, policy development, transportation, Mental Health therapist and case management services in the Detention Center.

**Broadwater County-** Feasibility study to determine crisis intervention and jail diversion needs.

<u>Custer County-</u> Develop and construct community-based secure and voluntary crisis stabilization facility, "Eastern Montana Crisis House".

<u>Gallatin County</u> – Continue Crisis Intervention Team and Mental Health First Aid training, expansion to include .15 FTE Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) in Detention Center, 2.0 FTE Peer Support Specialists for mental health outreach with law enforcement and mobile crisis program research.

<u>Hill County-</u> Mental Health First Aid and Crisis Intervention Team training; .2 FTE in Detention Center to coordinate referrals for Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder services; APRN and Licensed Clinical Professional Counselor (LCPC) for onsite emergent evaluations and assessments in Detention Center.

<u>Lake County-</u> Complete construction and begin operation of "Lake House" crisis stabilization facility by January 1, 2016, .5 FTE Mental Health Professional at crisis facility.

<u>Lewis and Clark County</u> – One (1) Full Time Mental Health Professional and one (1) Full Time case worker at the Detention Center (November 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016) and provide remaining funds to fully operate the 24/7 Crisis Response Team.

<u>Lincoln County-</u> Begin development of community-based secure and voluntary crisis stabilization facility, "Libby House".

<u>Missoula County –</u> New funds requested will be used to prepare a Preliminary Architectural Report for implementation of an emergency detention unit at the existing Dakota Place and Share House location. Continuing funds requested will sustain one (1) Full Time Mental Health Therapist at Missoula County Detention Facility; one (1) 18 hour per week on-call Mental Health Professional for response at Detention Facility, St. Patrick Hospital Emergency Department and Community Hospital Emergency Department; one (1) FTE Licensed Clinical Social Worker at St. Patrick Hospital in the Urgent Mental Health Clinic; one (1) 16 hour per week Mental Health Professional at the Access to Therapy Program at Partnership Health Center; Crisis Intervention Team training; and grant administration.

<u>Park County-</u> Start- up costs for Crisis Intervention Team training, .10 FTE Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner (PMHNP) and .05 FTE Mental Health therapist in Detention Center.

<u>Powell County</u> – Funds to assist with transportation to Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder treatment appointments, viability study to recruit Mental Health therapist for hospital clinic, funding for use of a hospital bed to assist individuals with symptom management and medication stabilization.

<u>Ravalli County</u> – Requested funds will support salary and benefits for one (1) FTE Certified Mental Health Professional on the team at West House crisis facility.

<u>Richland County</u> –New funds requested will support Mental Health First Aid training for 14 officers, 14 jailers and 2 health unit staff; salary and benefits for Registered Nurse in Detention Center; and will supplement medication funds to maintain medication adherence in Detention Center.

<u>Silverbow County-</u> Collaborate with service providers, Crisis Intervention Team training and continuing education, reduce crisis team response time, increase and expand protocol for Mental Health services in Detention Center, funding for 6 hours per month case management services in Detention Center.

<u>Valley County-</u> Provide crisis intervention services at Frances Mahon Deaconess Hospital, utilize Mental Health staff from Eastern Montana Community Mental Health Center for evaluation and treatment.

<u>Yellowstone County</u> – Community Crisis Center will continue to provide 24/7 access to crisis intervention services, additional funds requested will provide for one (1) Full Time Discharge Coordinator at Community Crisis Center to provide in-house discharge and case coordination, continued Crisis Intervention Team training.
