Short Title: STAB salary change

1. Purpose:

If the State adopts a broadpay pay plan as proposed, section 15-2-102 (2) regarding the salaries of the State Tax Appeal Board needs to be modified to permit the board members to continue to receive pay and longevity increases available to other state employees.

2. Background:

Section 15-2-102 (2) establishes the salaries for the STAB members by linking them to a grade level in the State's current payplan establishes in 2-18-312. If the legislature adopts the proposed broadband pay plan as proposed in DOA's bill (6101/23-003), the STAB members will be left without a means of receiving pay increases. These two bill requests will either be combined into one, or a coordination clause put in the bills.
