Short Title: Revise Board of County Printing Statute

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1. Purpose: HOUSEKEEPING

Provide the Board of County Printing with rule-making authority in 7-5-2404, MCA.

2. Background:

Currently the Board of County Printing is responsible for setting the maximum rates that newspapers may charge for county legal advertising, and adopting the county legal advertising printing standards for newspapers. The law requires the board to "adopt and publish" the rates and standards, but does not provide the board with authority to publish the information as an administrative rule.
