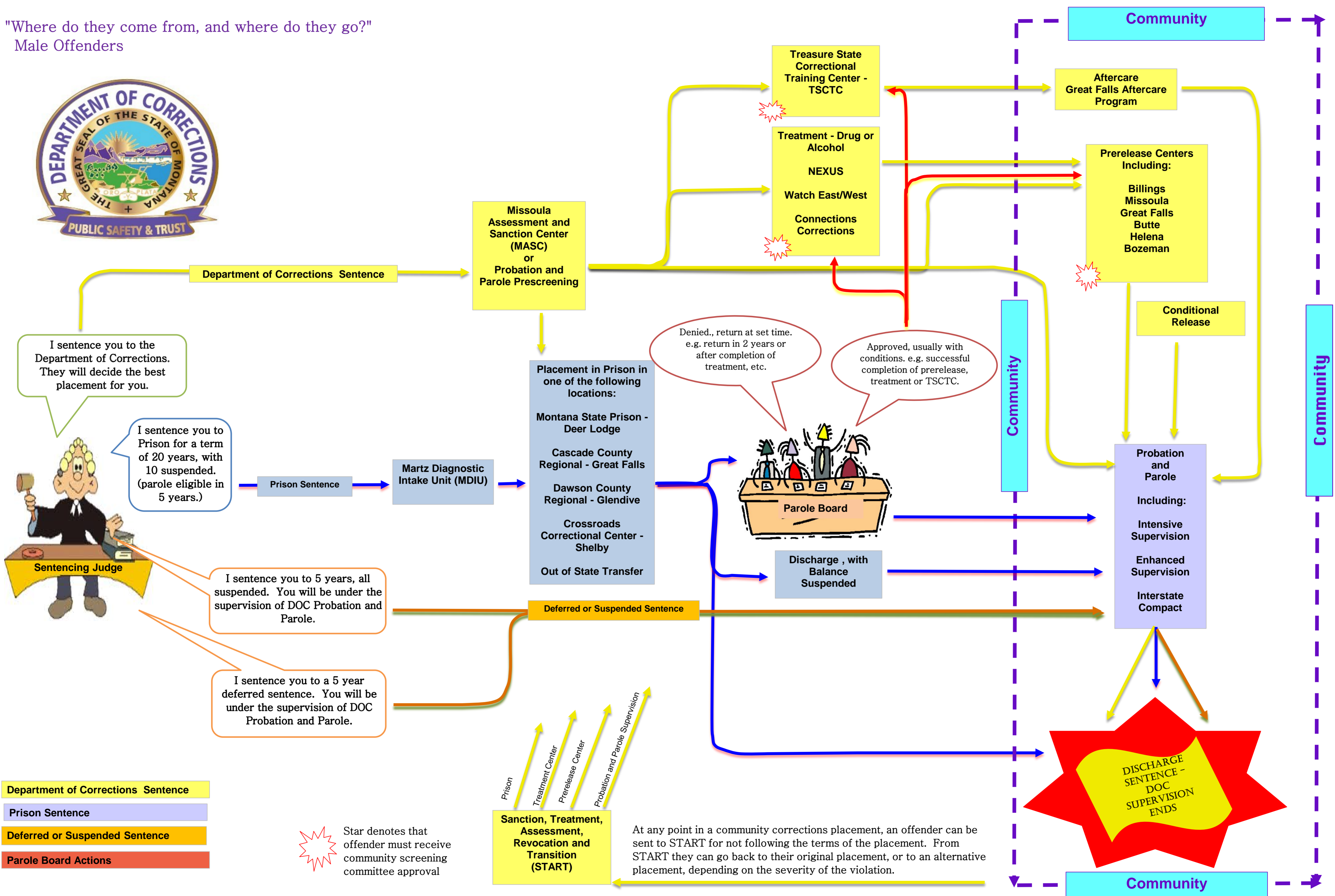


"Where do they come from, and where do they go?"
Male Offenders



I sentence you to the Department of Corrections. They will decide the best placement for you.

I sentence you to Prison for a term of 20 years, with 10 suspended. (parole eligible in 5 years.)

I sentence you to 5 years, all suspended. You will be under the supervision of DOC Probation and Parole.

I sentence you to a 5 year deferred sentence. You will be under the supervision of DOC Probation and Parole.

Denied., return at set time. e.g. return in 2 years or after completion of treatment, etc.

Approved, usually with conditions. e.g. successful completion of prerelease, treatment or TSCTC.

Star denotes that offender must receive community screening committee approval

Sanction, Treatment, Assessment, Revocation and Transition (START)

At any point in a community corrections placement, an offender can be sent to START for not following the terms of the placement. From START they can go back to their original placement, or to an alternative placement, depending on the severity of the violation.
