

## Impact of PREA on Department of Justice Grants

There are three Department of Justice (DOJ) grant programs subject to the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA) statutory provision related to the submission of Certifications and Assurances. Two of the grant programs are administered by the Office of Justice Programs (OJP): (1) BJA's Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, and (2) the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention's (OJJDP's) Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act (JJDP) Formula Grant Program. The third grant program, STOP (Services, Training, Officers, and Prosecutors) Violence Against Women Formula Grant Program, is administered by the Office on Violence Against Women (OVW).
