RE: Budget Amendments

BUDGET AMENDMENT ACTIVITY

As of June 8, 2012 the Legislative Finance Division received notification of 61 budget amendments certified by the Governor since the March 2012 Legislative Finance Committee meeting. These amendments increase total funds by \$24.0 million in FY 2012 and \$0.034 million in FY 2013. An additional 6.51 FTE in FY 2012 and 9.18 FTE in FY 2013 have also been added. Five amendments transfer existing authority between expenditure categories or between organizational units and 11 extend previously approved amendment authority. The figure below summarizes the budget amendments certified by the Governor from the period March 8, 2012 through June 8, 2012.
