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Dear Senator Williams,


Per your request, I am forwarding a current list of Historic Preservation grant funds currently unencumbered by the Department of Commerce. You will notice that of the \$3,894,460 appropriated for historic preservation grants in HB 645, \$3,624,460 remains unencumbered and not under contract. This portion of the overall appropriation represents the competitive grant portion of the program—the Department received 135 applications for these funds, but to date has not scored and ranked the applications. HB 645 contained three specific line item projects for historic preservation grants: St. Mary's Mission (\$40,000), Daly Mansion (\$50,000) and Traveler's Rest (\$180,000). Each of these projects is under contract and funds have been, and continue to be, disbursed to the grantees.
