


Montana Energy Mission II

- Purpose is to further improve international relations and explore partnerships in energy development.




Wind Energy

Governor, Air Force talk about fuel plant

HELENA - Gov. Brian Schweitzer told an Air Force official Tuesday that a coal-to-liquids plant at Malmstrom Air Force Base in Great Falls is a great fit for the state....

...Anderson said the plant could bring 1,000 jobs to Great Falls and start the Air Force on the path of using empty space on some of its bases to create a fuel that helps wean the country off foreign oil.



Air Force seriously pursuing fuel plant

The Air Force is seriously considering a partnership in which a potential commercial interest could build a 20,000 to 30,000 barrel a day coal-to-liquid-fuel plant at Malmstrom Air Force Base as early as 2011.

The plant, which would be financed and operated privately, is still in the early planning stages, "with a lot more wickets to pass through before it gets a green light," Assistant Air Force Secretary for Installations, Environment and Logistics William Anderson said Wednesday...




Montana Alberta Tie Ltd
