Type and Purpose of Action:

The proposed revision will add text to the permit clarifying the use of mobile fueling tanks on the mine. The mine has a need for fueling stations in closer proximity to where heavy equipment and machinery is in use. Approving the MR will allow the placement of fueling stations where needed.

The fuel tanks have double walls which provide secondary containment.

Potential Impacts and Mitigation Measures:

The use of fuel tanks in closer proximity to equipment will cut down on unnecessary travel along with the associated dust, road deterioration, and mine traffic. The tanks will have secondary containment and will be in locations previously disturbed with sediment control in place.
