Reading materials enclosed include:

- \* An agenda.
- \* The public comment received on the report, draft legislation and findings. Comments on the MBMG report and the Nicklin study also are enclosed. By the meeting date, I will have gone through it all and arranged it according to topic.
- \* Legislation proposed by the DNRC and the DEQ and approved by the EQC. (Some are water-related).
- \* By request of Sen. Juneau, a draft bill that would extend the Reserved Water Rights Compact Commission. This is an agenda item.
- \* A memorandum of understanding between the DNRC and the Bureau of Reclamation regarding the scope of work for conducting activities leading to preparation and execution of a contract for a municipal, residential, and industrial water supply from Hungry Horse Reservoir. This was discussed during the presentation on water marketing at the March 2008 meeting.
- \* The most recent water leasing report from FWP. This relates to water marketing and is statutorily required to be presented to the EQC. That presentation was made last month.
