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1. Which retirement systems would be covered by the legislation? If the proposal is limited to certain systems, please indicate the reason(s).

Judges Retirement System

2. What is the problem or issue?

The MJA is requesting that the retirement credit be increased from 1.785% to 3 1/3% for years 15 through 30. Currently, the judges and justices receive 3 1/3% a year for the first 15 years of service and 1.785% for each year after 15 years. This proposal would change the factor to 3 1/3% for all years of service up to, but not to exceed 30 years.

The retirement benefit would not be allowed to exceed the salary of an active judge or justice.

3. What do you want the legislation to do?

The Montana Judges Association wants to increase the retirement benefit for sitting judges or justices so there is a benefit of 3 1/3% for the first 30 years of service, not to exceed 100% of an active judge or justice.
