- Fraudulently filed returns are on the increase
- Fraudulent returns includes:
 - Identity theft
 - Fraudulently filed refund requests
- States and the IRS working in collaboration to combat fraud and prosecute fraudsters
- Growing problem nationwide
 - IRS Numbers:
 - 2011 \$14 Billion in fraudulent filed refunds stopped
 - 2012 \$20 billion in fraudulent filed refunds stopped
 - Increase of 43%
