 - Governor's Scholarship


Need-based Aid: based on your family's financial need.

 - SEOG




Financial Aid Awarded by Source, 2016-17

Includes all types of financial aid awarded in the MUS except loans; includes all grants, scholarships, waivers, discounts, and work study






MUS Financial Aid, Total Dollars Awarded

Academic Year Aid Received by <u>First-time</u>, <u>Full-time</u> <u>Resident</u> Students All Campuses




