As work group members may be aware, the Attorney General proposed a security freeze bill that provided food for discussion at the February 10 meeting of the Economic Affairs Committee. The work plan for SJR 38 specifies that the discussion topics to be prepared for the May Economic Affairs Committee meeting include victim assistance and restitution. So, in addition to discussing how to resolve issues related to a security freeze bill - as requested by the Economic Affairs Committee -- we will also be looking at possible victim assistance and restitution measures or ideas.
