1. Purpose:					
The Montana Military Family Relief Fund (MMFRF) would be established to provide short-term financial assistance, in the form of grants, to Montana National Guard members and/or families impacted by moblization/deployment. To qualify for a grant, the military member would have to meet the following criteria: the military member is a member of the Montana National Guard in good standing; a current Montana resident; ordered to active duty for at least 100 consecutive days pursuant to either Title 10 or 32 of the United States Code; and his/her salary has decreased, by a specified percentage, from the member's civilian salary.					
2. Background:					
Some Montana National Guard members and their families experience short-term financial turmoil/hardhip when a member of the Montana National Guard is mobilized for an extended period of active military duty. The MMFRF would be a resource whereby qualifying military members/families would receive grants, which would ease short-term financial burdens associated with the member being called to full-time military service.
