Board of Housing

Amending 8.111.409 Cash Advances to increase amount from \$10,000 to \$30,000 as amount that may be advanced at time of closing to satisfy property liens.

Issue #10

Department of Agriculture

Various changes to 4.13.1001A Grain Fee Schedule including office hours and what inspections will include.

Department of Labor

Amending prevailing wage rates and Occupational Safety and Health Code to conform with 2006 language.

Issue #11

Board of Speech-Language Pathologists and Audiologists

General revision of rules as part of Board's periodic review of rules, making technical changes, updating language, updating statutory references, and reorganizing and renumbering rules for easier reference and use.

Department of Labor

Increasing license fees for weighing and measuring devices in order for the fees to be commensurate with costs.

Department of Livestock

Increasing diagnostic laboratory fees due to increased cost of administering the diagnostic services.

Department of Labor

Adoption by reference of American National Standards Institute B30.5 providing minimum requirements and standards for the operation of crane and hoist equipment.

State Auditor

With respect to small business health insurance purchasing pools and premium assistance increasing businesses eligible from those with 2 to 5 employees to those with 2 to 9 employees.
